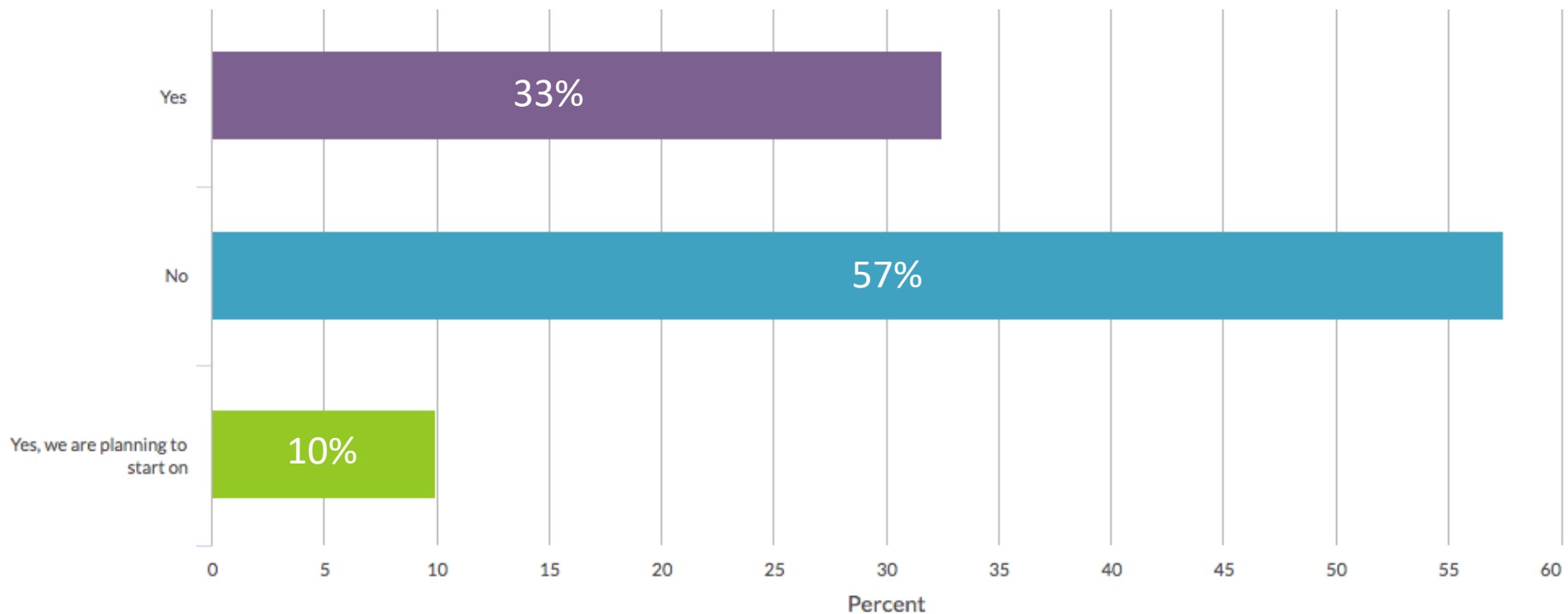




Report for Survey handling Cord Blood Donor Eligibility and COVID

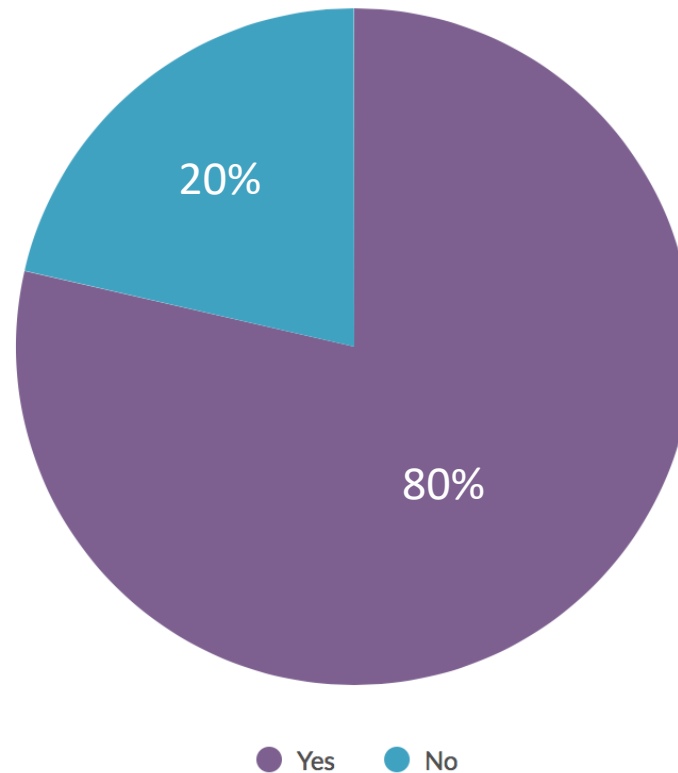

Questions:

- Cared for someone with COVID-19?
- Are you a health professional?
- Being locked down at home?
- Having a body temperature $> 37,5^{\circ}\text{C}$?
- Cough or respiratory symptoms?
- Have you had fever or clinical symptoms related to SARS-CoV-2 infection in the 14 days before and 14 days after delivery?
- according to indications of the Competent Authority?

Additions:

- We already have questions related to fever and pulmonary infection but not specific to Covid-19
- In all the risks situations we defined appropriate time-limits when a donation is possible or not and additionally perform a naso-pharyngeal Sars-CoV-2 test at birth
- Actually, All hospitalized persons are tested for COVID-19 (including the future mothers) and the result is available quickly ($< 24\text{h}$). In the future, the approach could be different with donor eligibility questions related to the COVID-19 pandemic

Additions:

- Specific Coronavirus screen with 2 questions asked by Coordinator and documented on form. Used for both cord blood and birth tissue donations. Time frame is "In the last 28 days". Defines/includes the CDC terminology of "Person Under Investigation (PUI)". Questions have sub-questions for obtaining additional information (e.g. date diagnosed or PUI & related healthcare professional contact information, date of close contact with person diagnosed or PUI). We already obtain donor's travel history in our questionnaires.
- Collection is suspended pending re-entry by hospital sites. Beginning in February, our staff screened for COVID-19 risk by assessing travel only. No policy has yet been established for COVID exposure risk, but we are reaching out to partner sites to coordinate resumption of collection activities.
- Moreover, we collect a post-donation information 15 days after donation, according to nation authorities dispositions.
- We are actively discussing additional COVID screening questions with our medical and regulatory department as well as environmental scanning of similar organizations for alignment.

Additions:

- The Bank will evaluate the maternal anamnesis with specific questions , in addition, will recover for the cryopreserved units the result of SARS-CoV-2 PCR from the collection center (if it is available) and will contact the mother to receive information about her health in the two weeks after the donation. Collection is suspended pending re-entry by hospital sites. Beginning in February, our staff screened for COVID-19 risk by assessing travel only.
