Location: The CENTOGENE Test Center is centrally located at Frankfurt Airport (FRA) between Terminal 1 and the national long-distance railway station (ICE station). The center is outside the transit area, so you need to have the necessary visa or residence permit to pass the security and immigration check point to take a COVID-19 test at the CENTOGENE Test Center.
