



HEMATOPOIETIC PROGENITOR CELL IMPORT OVERVIEW

This document is valid from November 17th, 2016 on.

The objective of this document is to inform the conditions of REDOME to request blood stem cells from unrelated donors of other registries.

These conditions will be presented at WMDA website and can be explained by our team during the request of cells. Deviations from these conditions must be approved by REDOME before the donation process starts.

ADDITIONAL TYPING REQUESTS

REDOME will request a minimum extended typing on:

- HLA-A, -B, -C, -DRB1, -DQB1 and DPB1.

CONFIRMATORY TYPING REQUESTS

REDOME will request confirmatory typing on a second sample (new sample collection) at minimum in the following loci:

- HLA-A, -B, -C, -DRB1, -DQB1, -DPB1

REDOME recommends that the confirmatory typing should be performed in an EFI/ASHI accredited laboratory.

- There must be no more than two major mismatches on these 5 loci between the donor and the patient for work up requests

WORK UP

Prescription

Prescription must be sent 30 days before the planned collection date. The ones sent with less than 30 days can be rejected if there are no available vacancies in the collection centers.

Donor Final Clearance Approval

The DFC must be approved up to the moment of donors' preparation or patients' conditioning.

COLLECTION AND IMPORTATION

Documentation regarding the stem cell entrance in Brazil will be provided by REDOME. Documentation necessary to leave the origin country must be prepared by the donor registry with the courier information provided by REDOME.

USE OF THE COLLECTED STEM CELLS

The collected cells are delivered exclusively for the purpose of hematopoietic stem cell transplantation of the designated patient. Cells in excess may be stored for future infusion for the same patient only. No other use of the collected cells is permitted. Cells which are not used for the transplantation of the designated patient must be properly disposed. REDOME must inform donor's registry the use and/or disposal of all cell components and its corresponding date.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Confidentiality must be guaranteed between donor and recipient. The name initials from donor or patient may be presented in documentation that accompanies the registry ID. This is a mechanism to increase the security in the

donors/patients' care. The exchange of anonymous letters is permitted 180 days after the transplantation. Gifts are allowed with the maximum value of BR\$ 100,00.

Requests to meet the patient can be done by the donor, the patient and if younger than 18, the patient's family. This revelation can occur only 18 months after the donation.
