

## INTERNATIONAL PATIENTS TRANSPLANTATION WITH REDOME DONORS

The restriction of donation to international patients is based only in the disease. There is no restriction to HLA compatibility and patient age, because REDOME considers that these criteria will depend on the protocol of treatment established by patient physician and transplant center. Once a request is made for REDOME, it is necessary to report the disease in the forms or in EMDIS connection. The patient disease is evaluated based on the following list authorized by Brazilian Ministry of Health (Ordinance MS 2600, October 21th, 2009). In case of non-listed diseases or specific indication, REDOME's medical committee will evaluate the request also considering the current practice in Europe published by EBMT every two years: *Bone Marrow Transplantation (2015) 50, 1037-56.*

- i) Acquired severe aplastic anemia;
- j) Constitutional aplastic anemia;
- k) Other hypoplastic marrow syndromes;
- l) Thalassemia
- m) Sickle cell disease
- n) Chronic Granulomatous Disease
- o) Kostman's Disease
- p) Histiocytic Disorders;
- q) Primary Immunodeficiency;
- r) Inherited Erythrocyte Abnormality;
- s) Inherited Metabolic Diseases;
- t) Inherited Platelet Abnormality;
- u) Plasma Cell Disorder;
- v) Other diseases.
