### Transplant Physician's Preferred Shipment Dates:

**By requesting this cord unit for the purpose of transplantation on behalf of the above named patient, I confirm that:**

1. Due to the degree of HLA match and DNA typing and all other laboratory results the above CB unit is the only best matched unit for the transplantation of this patient. Since the transplantation is to be performed very soon, I confirm that the transplant date cannot be changed and therefore the transport should be performed by a Courier Service.
2. The patient has been fully advised of the risks associated with this procedure.
3. It is the responsibility of the transplant center to choose the method of cord unit transport (courier or courier service). I understand that the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank and its affiliates are free of responsibility for the safe arrival of the cord unit once it leaves the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank laboratory.
4. The transplant center must agree that the CB unit will be thawed and processed prior to the transplantation using the thawing procedure from Düsseldorf, which is identical to the Rubinstein protocol (it is possible to receive a 'dummy CB unit' for practice use or training).
5. If, for any reason, this cord unit is not used for the purpose of transplantation on behalf of the above named patient, the transplant center will not return the said cord blood unit to the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank.
6. The transplant center assumes full responsibility for the return of the dry shipper provided by the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank within seven days of its arrival at the transplant center. If, for any reason, the transplant center is unable to return the dry shipper, or the dry shipper is damaged, the transplant center agrees to reimburse the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank for the cost of the dry shipper, based on current market value.
7. The transplant center agrees to provide the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank with post transplantation data at regular intervals by completing the post transplantation forms supplied by the Duesseldorf Cord Blood Bank.
