

## Conditions for cord blood unit shipment request

### CONDITIONS FOR CORD BLOOD UNIT SHIPMENT REQUEST

1. I hereby formally request this Cord Blood Unit (CBU) for the sole purpose of transplanting it to the patient mentioned on the next page.
2. By signing this document I confirm that the transplant centre has reviewed all available data and laboratory test results of this cord blood unit and will take full responsibility for the results of infusing this cord blood unit to the patient named on the next page.
3. By signing this document I confirm that if for any reason, this CBU is not used for the purpose of transplantation for this patient, the transplant centre will not return this unit to Sanquin Cord Blood Bank (CBB). Instead, the transplant centre will take care of immediate destruction of the unit.
4. By signing this document I confirm that the transplant centre agrees to provide Sanquin CBB with the thawing report and post transplantation data at regular intervals.
5. By signing this document I confirm that the transplant centre takes full responsibility for the transport of this unit from Sanquin CBB to the transplant centre, also in case alternative methods of transport are required. The transplant centre shall choose the method of CBU transport. I understand that Sanquin CBB is released of responsibility for the safe arrival of the CBU once it is handed over to the courier by the cord blood bank. All deliveries are "FCA" in accordance with ICC Incoterms 2010 at the address of Sanquin Blood supply Foundation, Plesmanlaan 125, 1066 CX, Amsterdam, The Netherlands. Name and itinerary of the courier will be provided as soon as possible, preferably one week before planned shipment of the unit.
6. By signing this document I confirm that the transplant centre resumes full responsibility for the return of the dry shipper within 1 week of arrival at the transplant centre. In case of failure to do so or in case of damage or loss, the transplant centre will reimburse Sanquin CBB for the cost of the dry shipper, based on current market value of a new dry shipper.
7. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of The Netherlands without regards for the conflicts of laws principles thereof. Disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement, including interpretation thereof, shall be submitted to the District court of Amsterdam, The Netherlands.
