Introduction

This Deliverable D2.1 Report on unrelated stem cell donations is part of the 2021 work programme of the WMDA for the EU Third Health Programme (2014-2020) and is based on the data of the WMDA Global Trends Report 2020. It focusses mainly on the export to and the import from EU Member States of hematopoietic stem cell products, including current volumes, patterns and trends as well as information related to quality and safety regulations and operational processes. This report will be used to baseline and track improvements to provide a resource to support hematopoietic stem cell and cord blood organisations in EU member states, EU candidate countries and European third countries.

Since 1997, the World Marrow Donor Association (WMDA) sends out an annual questionnaire to analyse the global trends in unrelated hematopoietic stem cell (HSC) and cord blood (CB) donation.

Approximately 95% of all hematopoietic stem cell and cord blood organisations worldwide participate in this prestigious project. Since 2017, WMDA's Search & Match Service statistics are also included in the WMDA Global Trends Report (GTR).

WMDA Global Trends Report

The WMDA is an international collaborative effort of organisations and professionals involved in HSC donation and transplantation. WMDA's mission is to promote global collaboration and sharing of best practices between its members for the benefit of patients and HSC donors.

One of the annual projects of the WMDA is to collect information on unrelated hematopoietic stem cell products provided by hematopoietic stem cell donor and cord blood organisations worldwide. The WMDA office has been collecting these data since 1997 and is proud to distribute the 24th edition of the WMDA Global Trends Report in 2020. A total of 103 organisations from 61 different countries providing HSC products participated in the GTR 2020. The WMDA questionnaire is included in this report as supplemental information. The complete WMDA Global Trends Report 2020 is accessible for WMDA members on our collaborative website¹. External interested organisations or professionals can request a copy via our email².

HSC donor and CB organisations voluntarily contribute data on the understanding that publications may result. Each organisation is free to use the data for its own internal use, however any use of the data for publication must receive approval of the WMDA Board or its designee.

WMDA Search & Match Service

Due to increasing globalisation and changing populations, a global network like WMDA is of great importance to facilitate a HSC donor search beyond country borders.

WMDA Search & Match Service connects almost 40 million unrelated HSC donors and CBUs worldwide and helps over 20 thousands patients receive HSCs from healthy donors every year. As the WMDA's centralised global database continuously grows, due to the combined efforts of its member organisations, more patients in need of hematopoietic stem cell donation can be helped.

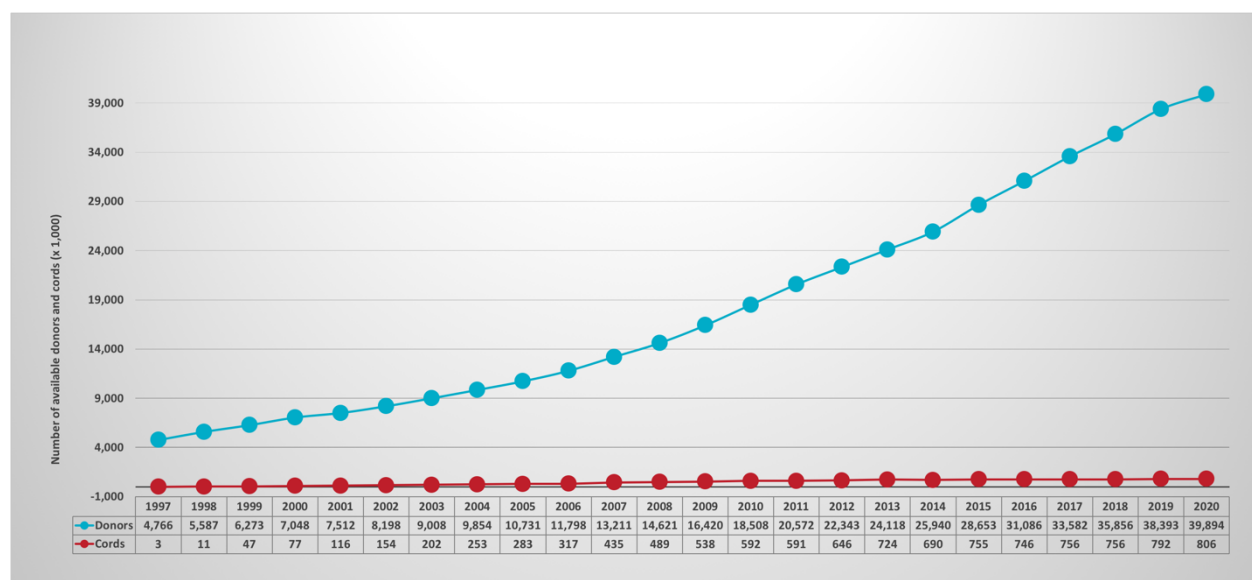
Global development

In 2020, 39 million unrelated volunteer HSC donors were registered, 806 thousand CBUs banked and over 2.2 million unrelated HSC donors and CBUs were recruited and banked. Figure 1 shows the global number of available unrelated HSC donors and CBUs over the years.

From 2008 on the number of available donors follows a more or less linear increase, showing there is still an increase in awareness about HSC donation. This increase is also driven by the increase of number of HSC donor organisations founded in previously unserved regions of the world. Since 2013 the combined inventory growth of CBBs worldwide has levelled off due to cost concerns and the increase use of haplo-identical family donors in favour of CBUs.

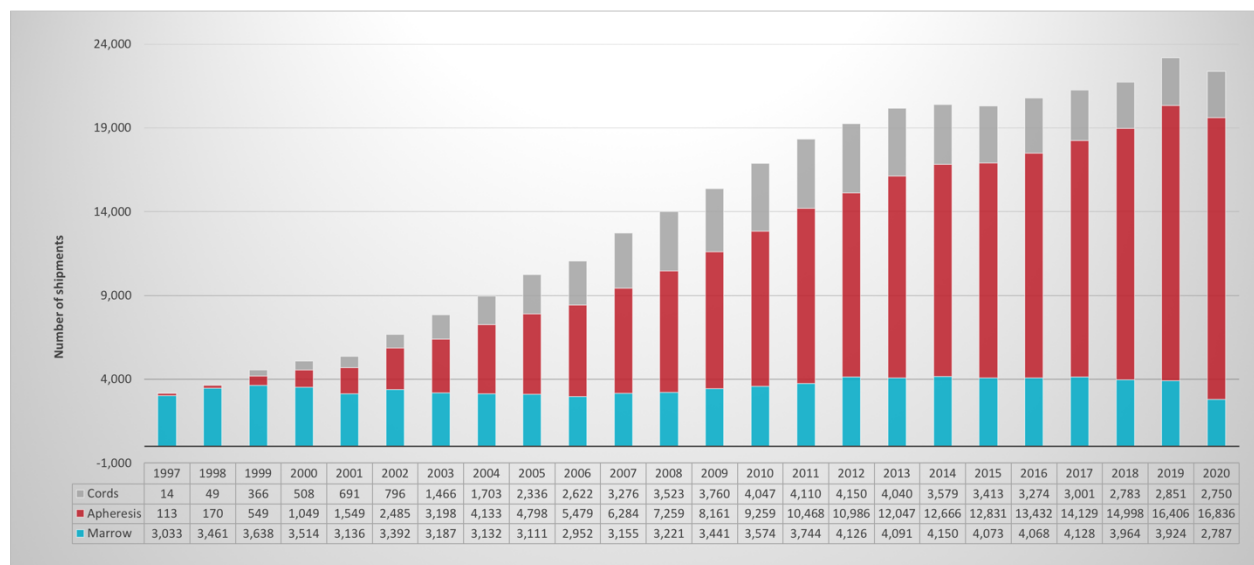
The number of new recruited HSC donors and newly banked CBUs in 2020 decreased by 28% compared to 2019. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 many HSC donor centres were unable to hold face-to-face donor recruitment events and had to move their activities online, which likely caused this decreased inventory growth.

On a global level, more than 22 thousand HSC products were donated for HSCT in 2020. Figure 2 shows the number and type of HSC products provided over the years. Also here we see a decrease compared to 2019 caused by border closings, unavailability of hospital services, and other difficulties due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The largest decrease (39%) was seen in the use of international marrow HSC donation and while the use of national apheresis HSC increased with 7%.

Globalisation is causing diversification of ethnicities; patients more often have a mixed ethnic background, or they might live in different a part of the world than where they are originally from. This might be why since 2014 we observe about 50% of all HSC products donated for HSCT are crossing international borders. In light of the Covid-19 pandemic, 2020 is divergent of this trend. Due to lock down situations in various parts of the world, transplant centres were more often forced to choose a national HSC donor. Figure 3 shows the percentage national and international provision of marrow and apheresis HSC donations worldwide.

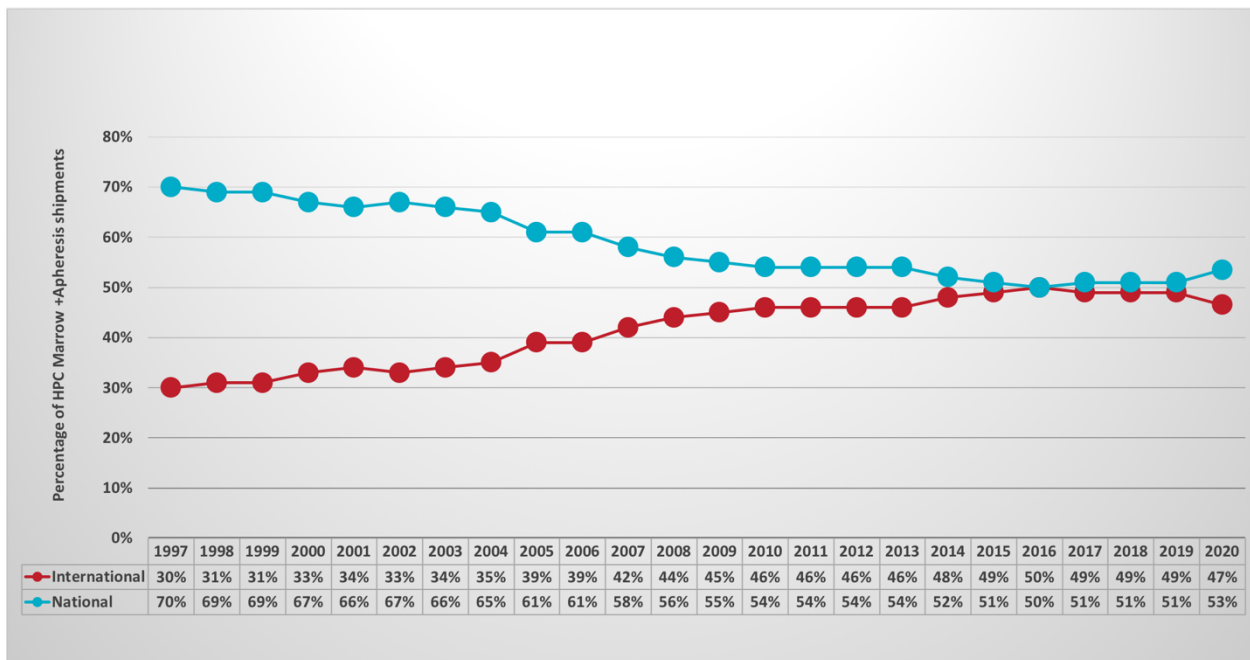
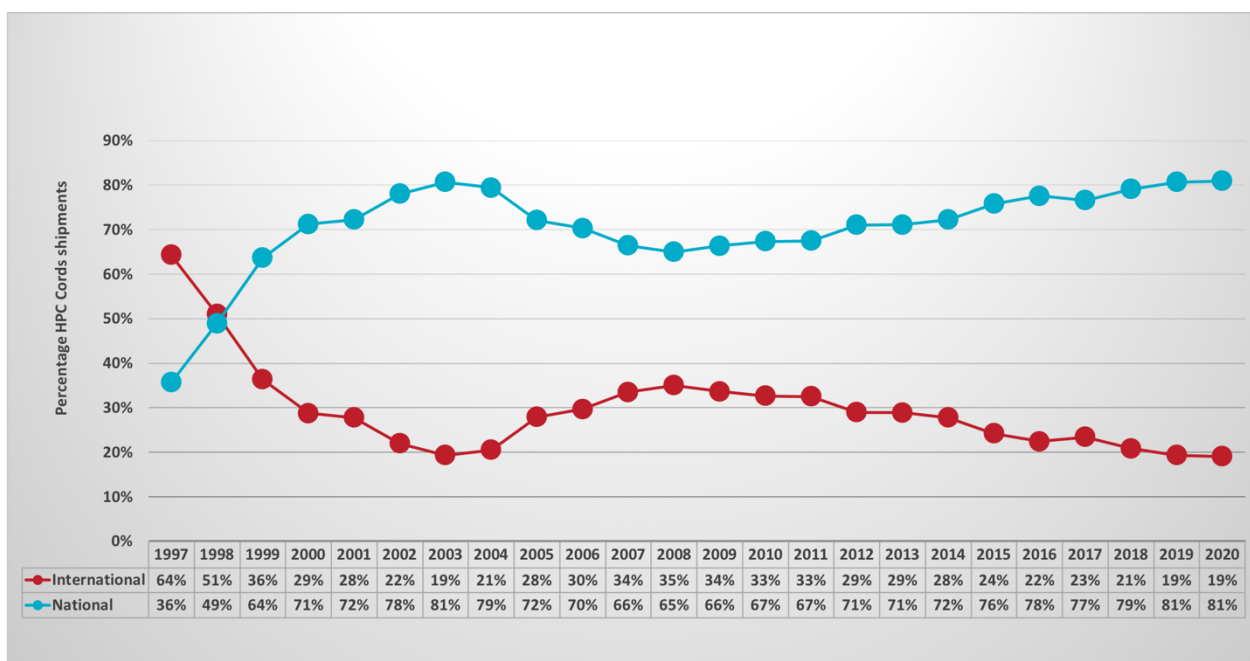


Figure 4, National and international provision of CBUs worldwide³

The use of CBUs do not follow this trend, 81% of CBUs were donated nationally and seemingly was not affected by the Covid-19 pandemic (Figure 4). This is mainly caused by the high rate of nationally used CBUs in Asia.

Figure 3, National and international provision of Marrow +Apheresis HSC products worldwide³

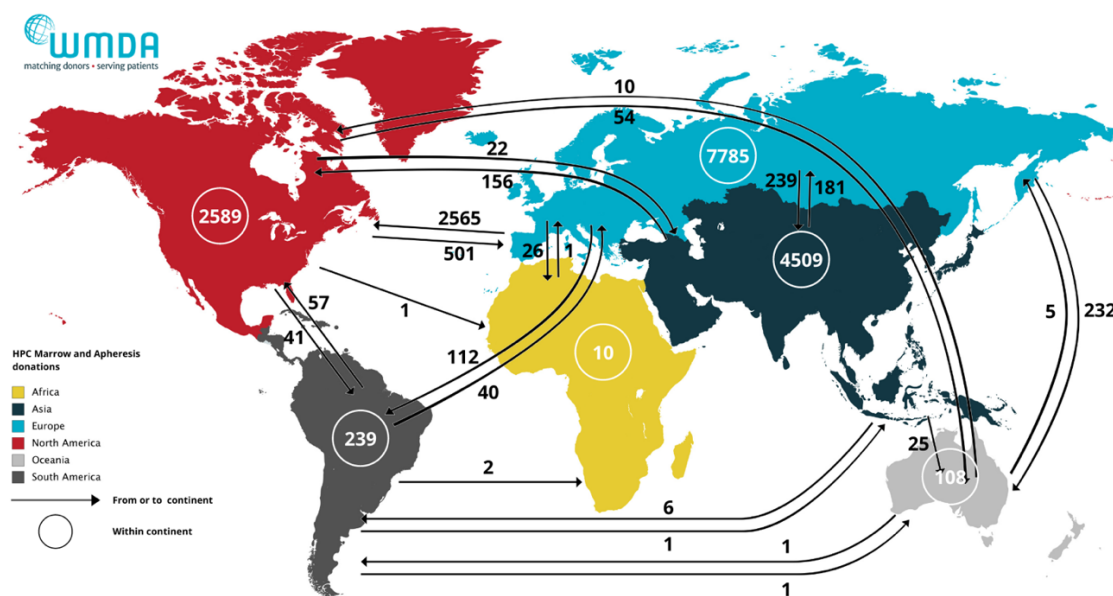


European development

With over 17 million unrelated HSC donors and CBUs available, Europe’s contribution to the global inventory is the largest of all continents with 42%. In 2020, more than 1.1 million donors were recruited and almost 5 thousand CBUs were banked. Compared to 2019 and compared to other continents, Europe’s decrease in recruiting new donors and CBUs was the largest as well, with 33%.

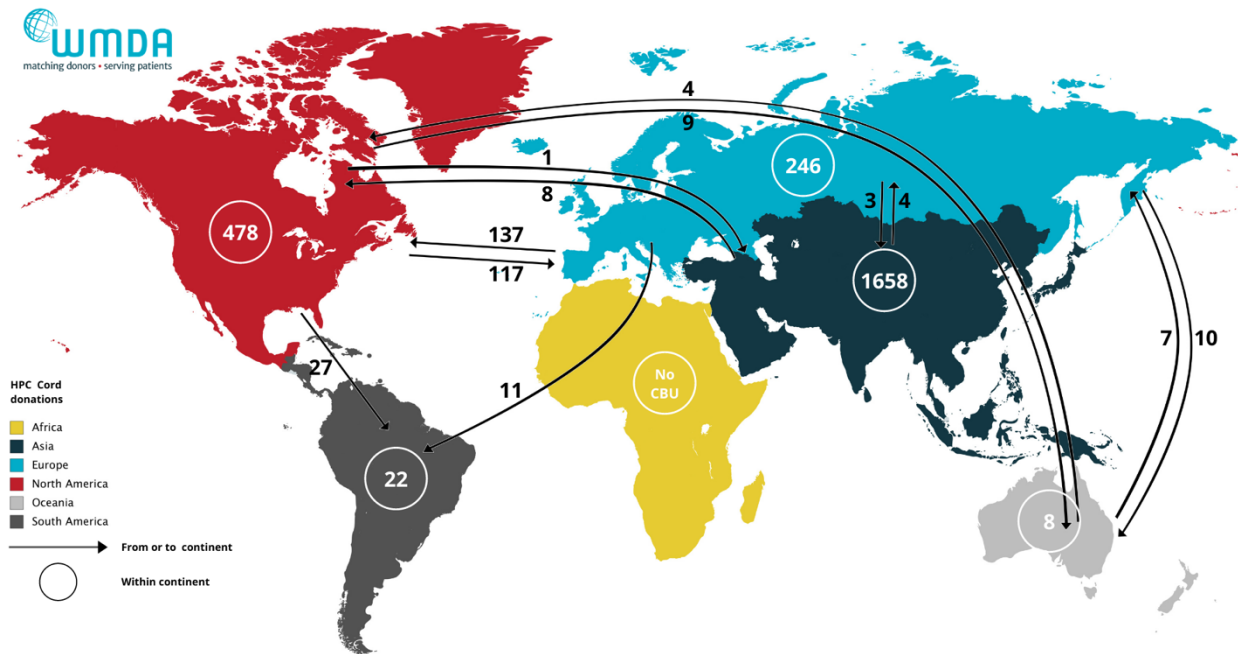
However, Europe remains the biggest exporter of HSC donor products as well as having a large internal market. Figure 5 shows the global exchange of Marrow and Apheresis HSC products. The large number of available HSC donors and CBUs in Europe, the concept of free movement between European countries and quality services provided by many European organisations are responsible for this.

Figure 5, Global exchange of Marrow and Apheresis HSC products³



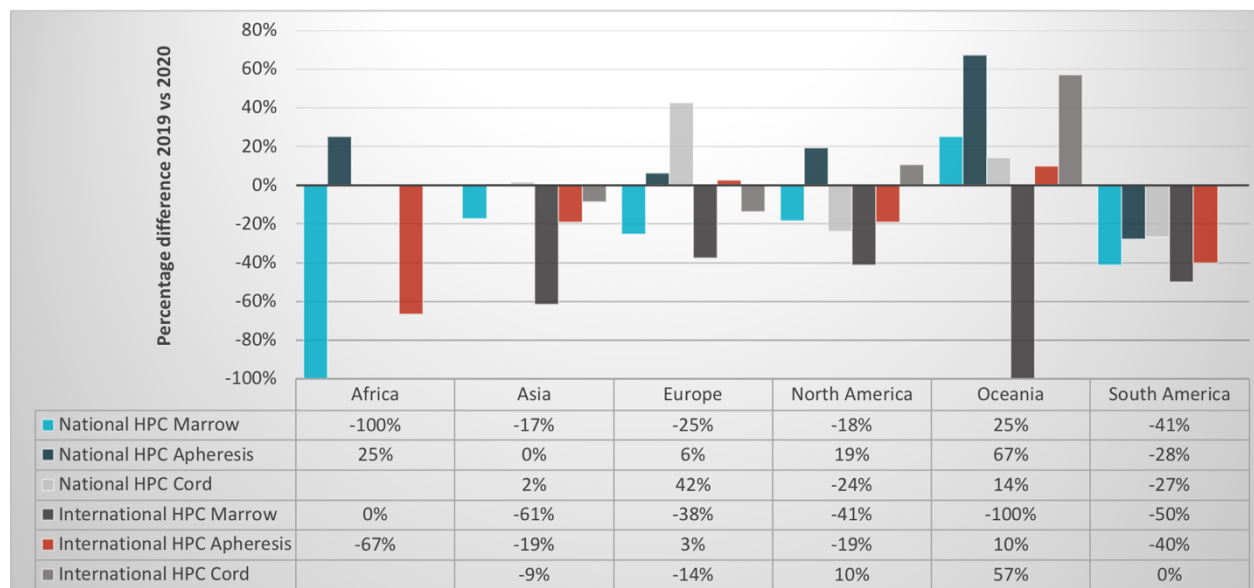
Despite not having the largest CBU inventory, European CBBs exported the largest amount of CBUs (Figure 6). However, the internal European market is only third largest after Asia and North America.

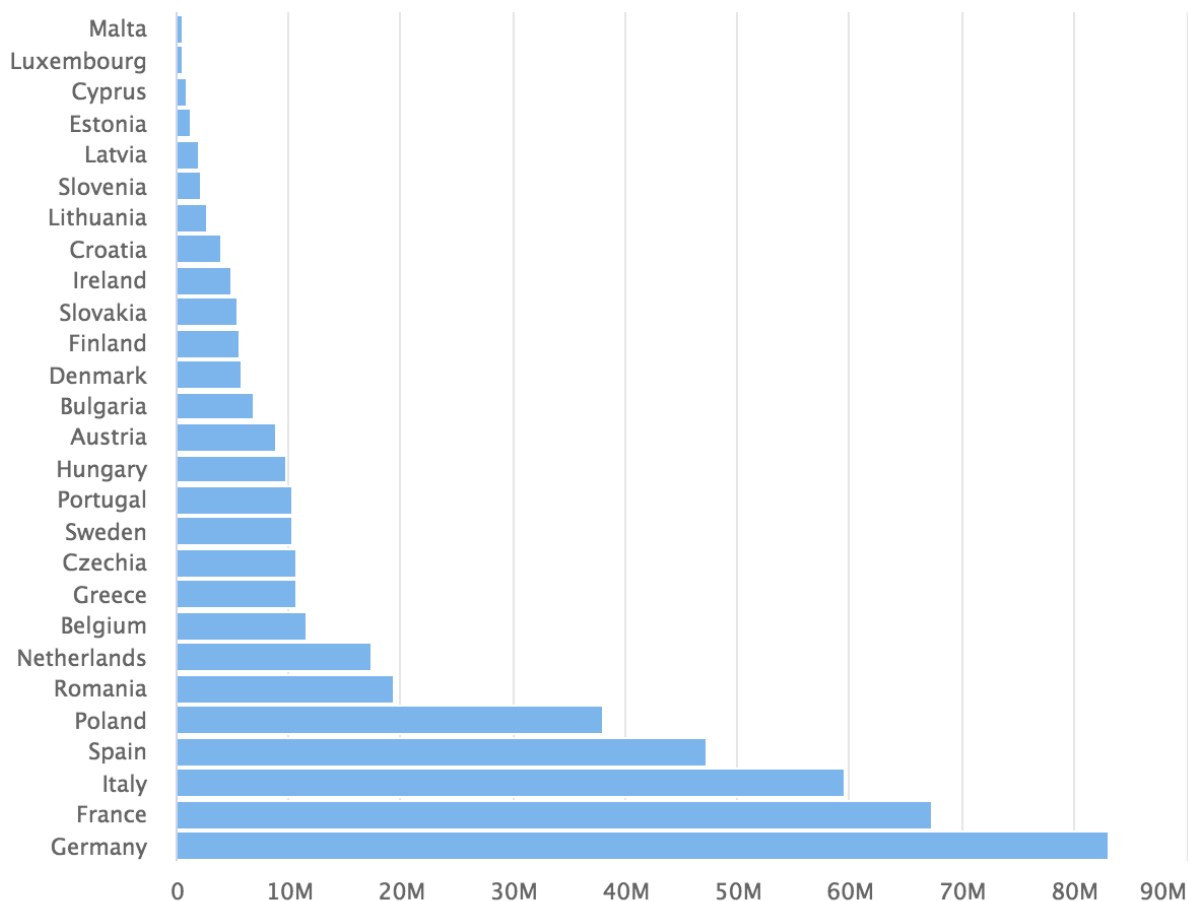
Figure 7, Covid-19 effects on the use of HSC product per continent³

The effects of the Covid-19 pandemic on the use of HSC donor products and CBUs was different for each continent. Following the global trend, in Europe the largest decrease was seen in the use of (mainly international) marrow HSCs with an increased use of (mainly national) apheresis HPCs. Contrasting with other continents, the use of national CBUs increased significantly with 42%. Figure 7 shows the effects of Covid-19 for all HSC donor and CB products per continent.

EU development

In 2020 the EU covered over 4.5 million km² and had 447.3 million inhabitants. By surface area, France is the biggest EU country and Malta the smallest. Germany, France and Italy hold the largest populations (Figure 8). In 2020 the EU consist of 27 countries, since the UK left the EU.

Data from Latvia, Estonia and Malta is missing since these countries do not have a HSC donor or CB organisation. Estonia collaborates with Finland to find unrelated HSC donors for their patients and therefore only import HSC products from other countries. Lithuania, Luxembourg, Portugal, Romania, Bulgaria, Denmark, Hungary and Ireland do not have a CBB and therefore only import CBUs from other countries. Germany is the largest supplier of unrelated HSC donor products and Spain is the largest supplier of CBUs.

In 2020, EU Member States exchanged 6.596 HSC products with other EU Member States and 4.956 HSC products globally.

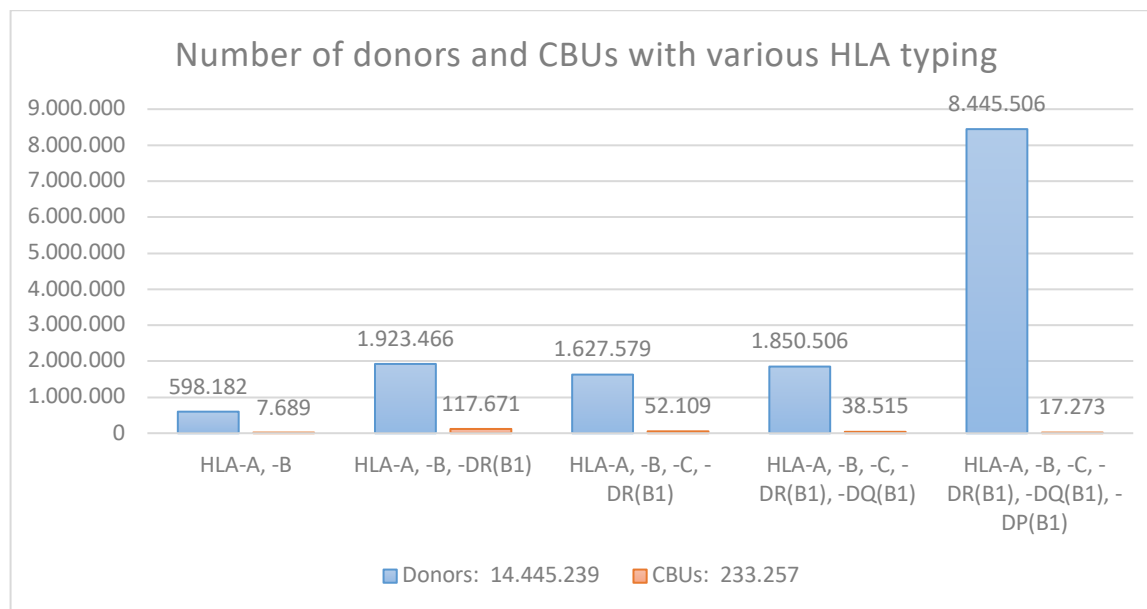

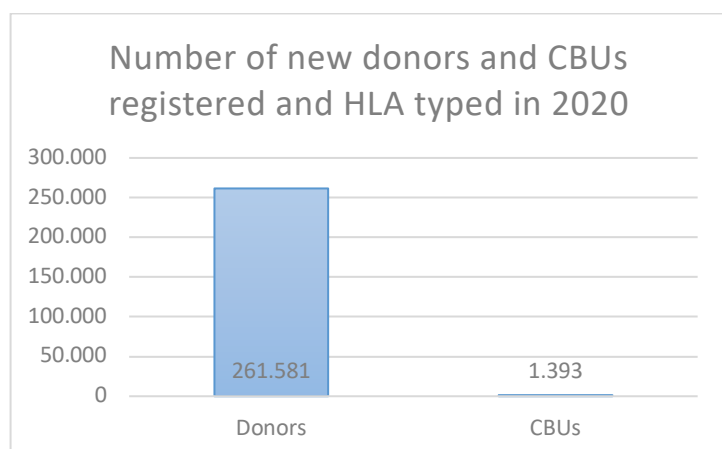

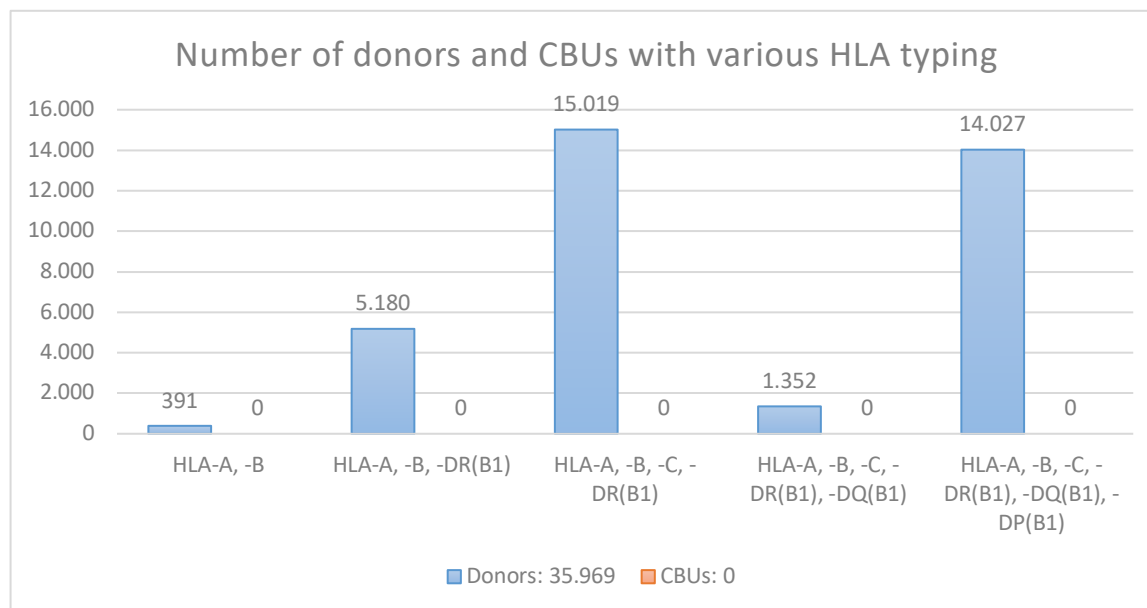

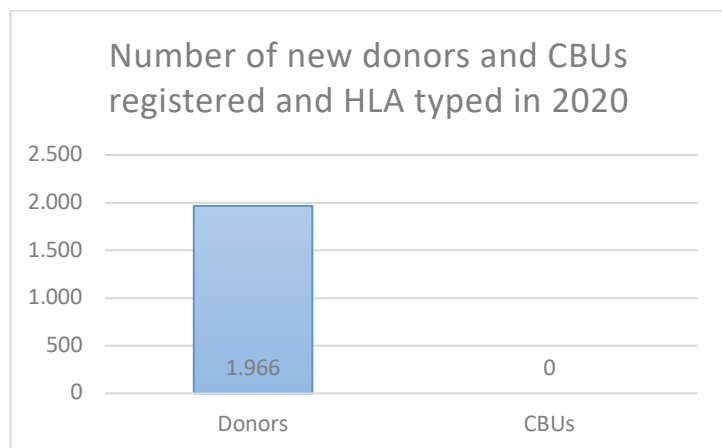

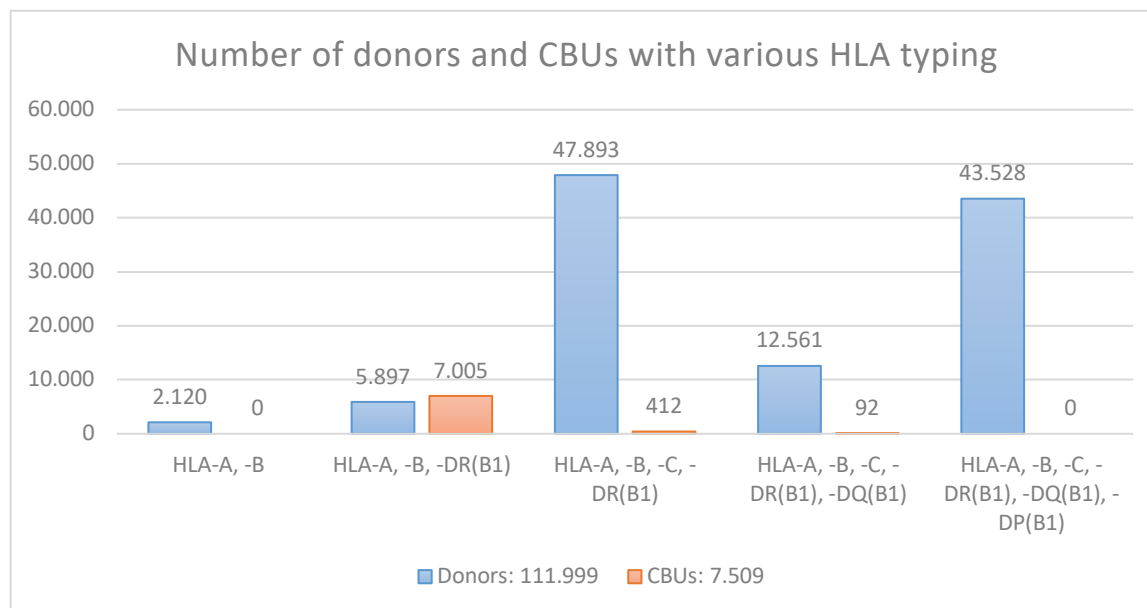

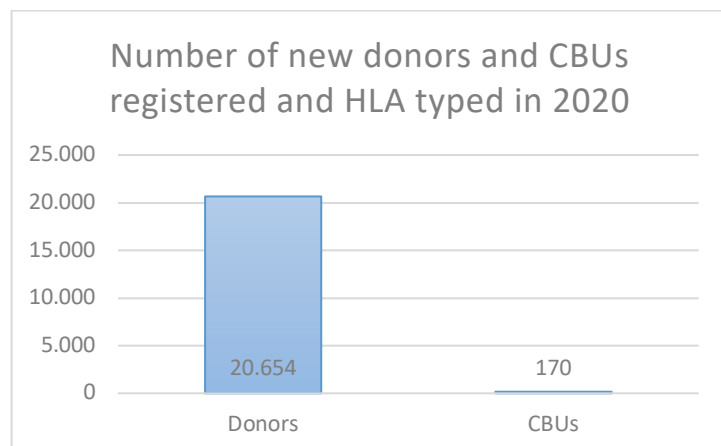
