Condition

Basic information

Chronic optic nerve damage, characteristically associated with unstable or a sustained increase in the intraocular pressure

Types

(Primary) open-angled glaucoma

(Primary) angle-closure glaucoma

Secondary glaucoma:

Drug-induced (corticosteroids)

Neovascular (diabetic retinopathy)

Inflammatory (iritis)

Traumatic / postsurgical

Developmental glaucoma
