Accept if no cardio-respiratory abnormalities

Guidance at CT/WORK-UP

- Accept for PBSC donation, if no cardiorespiratory abnormalities
- Accept for BM donation, subject to anaesthetic assessment at work-up. Document any additional risk factors for cardiovascular disease. Anaesthetist for BM procedure must be made aware of condition and pre-anaesthetic assessment at work-up.

Justification for guidance

Will need anaesthetic assessment at medical if for bone marrow harvest.
